Bill Analysis

SB 2150 lower the age an animal is considered an adult as it relates to the Commercial Pet Breeders and Animal Shelter Licensing Act from 12 months to 9 months. The measure specifies that a pet must not be available for adoption, sale, or transfer of any kind and privately owned. Possession of such an animal shall not include custody or control over an animal by a person who is not a resident of the state and is in the state for the sole purpose of attending a competitive show or event held in the state. The measure directs the Board of Agriculture to conduct at a minimum an annual inspection at each animal shelter or commercial breeder.
