Bill Analysis

SB 2157 creates the Southeast Scenic Rivers Act. The measure designates the Glover River, Kiamichi River, Little River, and Mountain Fork River as scenic rivers. The measure also creates the Southeast Scenic Rivers Commission to manage designated scenic rivers and directs funding to Commission to be provided in a separate line-item appropriation through the Oklahoma Wildlife Conservation Commission. The Commission shall be comprised of 11 members and shall be required to meet at least quarterly. The meetings of the Commission shall be subject to the Oklahoma Open Meeting Act and the Oklahoma Open Records Act. The Commission's responsibilities shall include the establishment of minimum standards for planning and other ordinances for counties to implement the provisions of this measure, identify nuisances, and to emphasize the preservation of designated rivers. The measure authorizes the Commission to hire an administrator.
