**Bill Analysis**

SB 2169 creates the Oklahoma Invasive Woody Species Stewardship for State-Leased Lands Act. The measure directs the Commissioners of the Land Office to identify and prioritize trust lands that have been harmed and devalued by invasive woody species by December 15 of each year. The Commissioners shall be authorized to enter into programs run by the Oklahoma Conservation Commission for the removal and management of invasive woody species and to coordinate with other government agencies to remove such invasive woody species. The measure directs the Commission to submit a report to the Legislature by February 15 of each year. The Commission is authorized to expend \$1 million each year to implement the provisions of the measure.
