**Bill Analysis**

SB 2171 requires state residents seeking to purchase a lifetime fishing license to have resided in the state for 1 year instead of 6 months. Such a person may also apply for a lifetime combination license upon payment of the difference in fee of the lifetime fishing license and lifetime combination license of \$649.00. The measure also directs the Oklahoma Wildlife Conservation Commission to authorize a controlled hunt to hunt and harvest velvet bucks on private land with consent of the landowner during the time beginning on the Saturday morning prior to the last full weekend of August to the Sunday evening of the last full weekend of August. Archery shall be the sole authorized method of hunting. The measure specifies that all velvet bucks killed or taken and harvested shall count against the licensee's annual bag limit for deer.
