**Bill Analysis**

SB 463 creates the Sportsman Hearing Protection Act. The measure provides that a suppressor manufactured and remaining in the state shall not be subject to federal regulation. The measure specifies that basic materials used to manufacture the suppressor shall not qualify the suppressor for federal regulation. The measure prohibits any state entity, political subdivision, or employee from enforcing federal regulations on such items. Additionally, none of the described entities may receive grant funding if such funding is contingent on the enforcement of federal regulations on suppressors.
