Bill Analysis

SB 660 creates the Oklahoma Foreign Agents Registration Act. The measure requires any person operating as a foreign agent for a foreign principal from a country of concern to register with the Ethics Commission. Such registration must be completed within 10 days of becoming a foreign agent. The measure provides the Ethics Commission with the authority to civilly enforce the provisions of this measure. Any activities conducted by the foreign agent must be reported within 60 days of the activity. Compensation received from a foreign entity must be reported within 12 months. Informational materials distributed in the state must be accompanied by a statement that such material is distributed on behalf of a foreign principal from a country of concern and must be retained by the agent for reporting purposes. The Attorney General shall have exclusive authority to investigate and enforce criminal violations of this measure. The measure establishes a maximum fine of \$500,000.00 and a maximum term of imprisonment of 5 years. The provisions of this measure shall not apply to diplomatic or consular officers, officials or employees of a foreign government, and attorneys engaged solely in legal representation in judicial or administrative proceedings.
