**Bill Analysis**

SB 68 authorizes each agency to employ information technology personnel to develop and implement the agency's technology strategy. The employing agency is required by the measure to enter into a memorandum of understanding with the Chief Information Officer (CIO). The measure authorizes the CIO to audit the state agency's compliance. The measure also adds the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation, the District Attorneys Council, the Office of the Attorney General, the Office of the State Auditor and Inspector to the list of state agencies exempt from the provisions of the Information Technology Consolidation and Coordination Act.
