Bill Analysis

SB 701 authorizes the State Regents for Higher Education to approve functional exceptions. A function exception is defined as an expansion or exception to assigned institutional function or mission to permit an institution of higher education within The State System of Higher Education to offer courses or degree programs outside the institution's assigned function or mission to meet unmet workforce needs. The measure also repeals a section of law that prohibited undergraduate courses from being offered through OSU to duplicate those offered by Tulsa Community College.

Repealer: 70 O.S. Section 4665

House Amendments

HA's to SB 701 completely replaces engrossed language with the language described above.
