Bill Analysis

SB 735 creates the Voter Roll Integrity and Maintenance Act. The measure directs the Secretary of the State Election Board to submit an annual report to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, Speaker of the House, and Governor no later than January 31 of each year. The measure also directs the secretary of a county election board to prepare and submit an annual report to the Secretary no later than January 15 of each year. The reports shall summarize efforts undertaken to prevent non-citizens from voting, remove non-citizens or other ineligible persons from the voter rolls, coordination efforts with other entities to determine voter eligibility, and provide analysis of the efficacy of current voter registration maintenance processes. The Secretary's report shall include aggregated state data. The measure subjects county secretaries to possible disciplinary procedures for repeated failure to comply.
