Bill Analysis

SB 74 appropriates \$300 million from the General Revenue Fund to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce to implement a program of reparations for damages to persons and property that occurred during the events of the Tulsa Race Massacre. The Department shall create and administer the program in conjunction with relevant groups. Survivors of the massacre as well as their descendants may apply for reparations. The measure also establishes a 3-person committee comprised of the Senator and House member from the Greenwood District in Tulsa as well as the Chief Executive Officer of the Department. The committee shall coordinate with the Department. Additionally, the committee shall meet to appoint 6 other members to the committee. The measure establishes the Tulsa Race Massacre Compensation Revolving Fund.
