## **Bill Analysis**

SB 745 extends from 26 to 30 the oldest age an individual can be to be given the opportunity to complete high school. It states that, beginning in the 2025-2026 school year, individuals between the ages of 21 and 30 shall only be eligible to complete high school if they attend a full-time virtual education program. It also excludes such individuals from being included in the calculation of a school's A-F report card. The measure also requires such persons to be lawfully present in the United States.

## **House Amendments**

HA's to SB 745 adds language requiring any person completing high school as an adult to be lawfully present in the United States.
