Bill Analysis

SB 757 allows a student to be placed in out-of-school suspension for demonstrating threatening behavior. It states that a school is not required to provide education services in the regular school setting to a student who has been removed from a public or private school for committing an act of threatening behavior. It also states that a student who has been suspended for committing such acts is not allowed to return to a teacher's classroom without the approval of the teacher if the threatening behavior was directed at the teacher.
