**Bill Analysis**

SB 883 prohibits any person from manufacturing, selling, or distributing an abortion-inducing drug. Any person who is convicted of violating this prohibition shall be guilty of a felony and subject to license revocation. The measure repeals provisions of law that regulate abortion-inducing drugs, including the Oklahoma Abortion-Inducing Drug Risk Protocol Act and the Oklahoma Abortion-Inducing Drug Certification Program Act.
