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Bill Analysis

SB 941 requires manufacturers of pharmaceutical products to publish a complete and detailed list of all ingredients for each product. The measure requires such manufacturers to also disclose whether such products use mRNA or other gene-based technology. The ingredients shall be submitted to the State Board of Pharmacy, published on a company-owned website, and included in product labeling and marketing materials. Such responsibilities to disclose shall remain regardless if an emergency is declared. The measure establishes a maximum fine of \$50,000.00 per violation, per product. Willful violations shall subject such manufacturers to a maximum fine of \$100,000.00 for a second violation and \$250,000.00 for third and subsequent violations. Such manufacturers may also be prohibited from selling products in the state for 1 year. The measure provides for criminal liability and subjects such persons to up to 1 year imprisonment. The measure also provides for civil liability.

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
