**Bill Analysis**

SB 943 creates the Oklahoma Medical Freedom Act. The measure provides that the right of an individual to refuse any medical procedure or vaccine shall not be questioned or interfered with in any manner. The measure provides that health care professionals questioning medical mandates, advocating for informed consent, and disclosing information relating to unethical practices shall be protected from disciplinary actions. Licensing boards may not revoke, suspend, or threaten the licensure of healthcare professionals for engaging in protected speech or whistleblowing activities. The measure provides a cause of action for such professionals and individuals.
