**Bill Analysis**

SB 955 provides that any person offering testimony to the Legislative Oversight Committee on State Budget Performance, the Appropriations Committee of the Senate, or the Appropriations and Budget Committee of the House of Representatives shall be required to affirm under oath that he or she will testify truly, or that any written testimony provided is true or believed to be true. The measure establishes a misdemeanor for any person who knowingly makes false statements, conceals material facts, or presents any false writing or document.
