Bill Analysis

SJR 15 submits to a vote of the people a constitutional amendment that eliminates all property taxes in the state and directs counties to develop a proposal to retain, establish, and modify the service districts and services provided funded by the property tax to be eliminated by this proposal. The measure authorizes the levy of a consumption tax on the final sale of all goods and services sold in the county and sold to consumers in the county. The levy of a consumption tax must be approved by voters of the county in a special election. The measure provides for the county to continue to call a special election until a consumption tax is approved.
