**Bill Analysis**

SJR 32 refers to a vote of the people a constitutional amendment that modifies the required signatures needed to place an initiative petition on the ballot. The SJR provides that the number shall be based on number of votes cast for the state office receiving the highest number of votes at such election instead of for the office of Governor. The SJR also authorizes the residents of a county to bring petitions for any purpose authorized by law. Additionally, it modifies the needed number of petitioners for county petitions from the current ratio of double the ratio to the whole number to 11.5% or 5,000 signatures, whichever is smaller.
