**Bill Analysis**

SJR 34 refers to a vote of the people a constitutional amendment that prohibits any person from performing or attempting to perform an abortion. The measure authorizes medical providers to deliver an unborn person if the life of the pregnant woman is threatened, provided the provider makes every reasonable effort to preserve the life of the unborn person. Any person who is convicted of violating the provisions of this SJR shall be guilty of murder in the first degree as well as subject to civil damages. The SJR clarifies that it shall not prevent the use of contraceptives used to prevent conception.
