Bill Analysis

SJR 43 calls for a state Constitutional Convention beginning July 12, 2027. The Convention would review and possibly amend the Oklahoma Constitution. The Convention would be comprised of 112 delegates. 76 of the delegates would be from the Legislature, 14 from the Executive Branch, 6 delegates would be judges, and 16 of the delegates would be from the public at large. The SJR also creates the Constitutional Convention Commission to create the forms for the public to apply to be a delegate. Members of the public shall be selected to serve as delegate by drawing lots. Each delegate shall receive travel reimbursements for a period of 90 days. Any change in the Constitution or new Constitution must be presented for approval to state voters during the General Election of 2028.
