            As used in this section, the term "invasive woody species"
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    means a tree or shrub species that is rapidly encroaching into

    adjoining lands and is likely to cause harm to the environment or

    economy. Invasive woody species include, but are not limited to,
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    Juniperus virginiana (Eastern Redcedar), Juniperus scopulorum (Rocky
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    Mountain juniper), Juniperus monosperma (oneseed juniper) and
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    Tamarix ramosissima (salt cedar).

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1 and management of invasive woody species within rights-of-way under 2 its jurisdiction. The eradication program shall include the 3 following components: 1. Surveys to identify the presence and extent of invasive 4 5 woody species; 6 2. Development of a prioritized plan for eradication and 7 control; 8 3. Use of best management practices for removal, including methods that minimize harm to native vegetation and prevent soil 10 erosion; 4. Monitoring and follow-up measures to prevent 11 12 reestablishment; and 1.3 5. Collaboration with local, state, and federal agencies, as 14 well as nongovernmental organizations, to leverage expertise and 15 resources. SECTION 2.
