7	An Act relating to military infrastructure funding; creating the Base Infrastructure Needs and
8	Development - Technology Revolving Fund; establishing the fund at the Oklahoma Military Department;
9	establishing revolving fund characteristics; deeming funds appropriated; providing expenditure and
10	budgeting requirements and limitations; creating the Base Infrastructure Needs and Development -
11	Technology Program; establishing program at the Oklahoma Military Department; authorizing certain
12	utilization of funds; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an
13	emergency.
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16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 301B of Title 44, unless there
19	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
20	A. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving
21	fund for the Oklahoma Military Department to be designated the "Base
22	Infrastructure Needs and Development - Technology Revolving Fund",
23	which may also be cited as "BIND - Technology Fund". The fund shall
24	be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and

1 shall consist of all monies directed for deposit to the fund by law. All monies accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby 2 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma 3 Military Department for the purpose established in subsection B of 4 5 this section. Expenditures from said fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as 6 7 prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment. 8

9 Β. There is hereby established within the Oklahoma Military Department the "Base Infrastructure Needs and Development -10 11 Technology Program", which may also be cited as the "BIND -12 Technology Program". The Department shall utilize funds from the 13 BIND - Technology Fund created in subsection A of this section, 14 alone or in combination with other available funding, to make 15 infrastructure investments, including, but not limited to, the 16 purchase of licenses and software associated with military 17 simulation training, that will either:

Decrease the likelihood of military base and other military
 infrastructure closures in this state; or

20 2. Increase the likelihood of military base and other military
21 infrastructure expansions in this state.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025.
 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
