19	Section 21. The repeated use of any real property or structure			
20	thereon to commit unlawful drug distribution, prostitution,			
21	violations of the Massage Therapy Practices Act, or human and/or sex			
22	trafficking acts which result in a felony conviction under the			
23	Oklahoma Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act may shall			
24	constitute a public nuisance.
