 - 4. Twenty-eight (28) days of instruction post the passage of the applicable competency examination.
 - C. A certified teacher who earns a CALT micro-credential or a CERI micro-credential shall be authorized to screen students for and identify characteristics of dyslexia.
 - D. A micro-credential awarded pursuant to this section shall be reflected on a teacher's certificate to teach.
