**Bill Summary and
Fiscal Analysis:**

HB1122 separates the Oklahoma State Athletic Commission from the State Department of Health, authorizes the Commission to have jurisdiction over professional boxing and kickboxing, allows the Commission to halt the unlicensed promotion of professional combative sports events and seek penalties against those engaging in unsanctioned events, clarifies when and how HIV, hepatitis B and hepatitis C testing must be conducted, and removes the ability to waive the requirement for such test results.

As the Oklahoma State Athletic Commission is not an appropriated agency, there is no direct fiscal impact.
