**Bill Summary and
Fiscal Analysis:**

This bill authorizes the Board of Regents of the University of Oklahoma to establish within the College of Education a pilot program to provide high-dosage mathematics tutoring for the lowest performing ninth grade students, based on performance on mathematics assessments administered in the eighth grade. It directs the pilot program to operate in high schools in districts with 30,000 or more enrolled students and public charter schools.

The University of Oklahoma indicates a cost of \$3,000,000 for the pilot program cost.
