**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

HB1375 directs the Oklahoma Corporation Commission to engage an outside consulting firm to conduct a technical and legal feasibility study on promoting nuclear energy generation, lists requirements of the study, and limits the Corporation Commission from expending more than \$375,000 to compensate a consulting firm to conduct the study.

The maximum fiscal impact of the proposal is \$375,000. If the Corporation Commission is unable to hire a consulting firm for less than that, Section 3 of the proposal directs that the Commission may conduct a notice of inquiry to conduct the study and report.
