**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

HB 1380 establishes the Insulin Access and Affordability Program at the Department of Health.

The purpose of the program is to increase competition, lower insulin prices, and address shortages in the market. The agency may enter into agreements with nonprofit pharmaceutical companies for Oklahomans access to insulin. The measure allows a match of state appropriations, however no appropriation to the program is made.
