Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

This bill directs the State Board of Education to adopt a separate parental consent form that school districts must use to determine whether a student who has an individualized education program (IEP) will participate in the Oklahoma Alternate Assessment Program (OAA) and be provided instruction that will be assessed by alternate achievement standards. It states that a school district cannot provide alternate instruction or an alternate assessment without parental consent unless the district documents reasonable efforts to obtain consent and the child's parent has failed to respond or the district obtains approval through a due process hearing.
