Full Year Impact:

HB 1460 would eliminate various fees and fines. The measure would also expand a court's ability to waive financial obligations. The breakdown of the fiscal impact to the agencies' revolving funds and the Courts is listed below.

Department of Corrections(DOC): \$219,159.58

OK Bureau of Narcotics & Dangerous Drugs(OBN): \$25,000

Department of Public Safety(DPS): \$111,318.09 Administrative Office of the Courts(AOC): \$64,086

State Department of Education: \$50,402*

The total estimated decrease in revenue collections for a full year is \$469,965.67, however there is the possibility of a greater decrease in revenue dependent on any increase in financial obligations waived by the courts.

*This is an average of yearly(FY'22-FY'23) collections to the Drug Abuse Education and Treatment Revolving Fund. A breakdown of the collections to the fund by conviction is pending a response and has the potential to lower the fiscal impact.
