Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

HB1512 authorizes the Oklahoma Insurance Commissioner to apply for a waiver with the U.S. Secretary of Health and Human Services that would allow the state to modify certain requirements of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (42 U.S.C, Section 18052). The proposal also creates the State-based Exchange Revolving Fund at the Oklahoma Insurance Department.

The Oklahoma Insurance Department is not an appropriated agency. There is no fiscal impact to the state.
