**Bill Summary and
Fiscal Analysis:**

HB1728 creates the Salt Cedar Eradication Act and directs the Oklahoma Conservation Commission, in collaboration with the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry (ODAFF) and the Oklahoma Water Resources Board (OWRB), to administer the Act to control and eradicate invasive Salt Cedar species in counties within the Upper Red River Basin. The measure also creates the Salt Cedar Eradication Revolving Fund.

There is no fiscal impact. The Conservation Commission shares that any funding would have to come in the future or from outside grants
