**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

HB 1822 mandates that the Oklahoma Department of Transportation implement a program to identify, remove, and manage invasive woody species within rights-of-way under its jurisdiction.

ODOT anticipates an approximate \$15,000,000-\$20,000,000 impact over 10 years to comply with the requirements of the bill. It also anticipates a need to dedicate at least 5 existing employees from each of the 8 field districts for a total of 40 employees working full time on the program.
