**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

HB 1849 establishes the Teacher Recruitment and Retention Program administered by the Oklahoma Partnership for School Readiness. The measure also establishes a sunset provision of November 1, 2028

The program will ensure that any employee at a licensed childcare facility shall have their household income exempted from consideration when for eligibility in the childcare subsidy program.

DHS believes a total state cost of \$21,000,000 exists to implement this program. However, a large portion of employees at licensed childcare facilities have children already on the childcare subsidy program. Therefore, DHS believes the total cost of the measure to be approximately \$11,500,000.
