## Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

HB1851 requires a person or entity that offers an automatic renewal contract to a consumer to present the automatic renewal offer terms in a clear and conspicuous manner before the contract is executed, and provide the consumer with a written acknowledgement that includes the automatic renewal offer terms, details on cancellation policies, recurring charges, purchase obligations, and requires businesses to inform consumers and provide cancellation instructions if there are material changes to the contract. Certain industries are exempt from these requirements. The Office of the Attorney General is instructed to enforce the provisions of the act.

The Office of the Attorney General estimates an annual fiscal impact of approximately \$230,000 for the salary and benefits of an additional attorney and 0.5 FTE to administer the provisions of the proposal.
