**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

HB1910 authorizes the Oklahoma Conservation Commission to establish and administer the Urban Agriculture Cost Share Program to promote sustainable urban agricultural practices, improve food security, and enhance green spaces in Oklahoma's urban areas. The program is to be funded by the Oklahoma Conservation Commission Infrastructure Revolving Fund. When funds are available and sufficient, the Commission shall develop and disseminate the program guidelines to the conservation districts containing urban areas.

The Conservation Commission states that there is no fiscal impact.
