**Bill Summary and
Fiscal Analysis:**

HB2011 creates the Fighting Chance for Firefighters Act, allowing cancer centers in the state to carry out the provisions of the act to cover the costs of occupational cancer screenings. The proposal also allows the Oklahoma Health Care Authority, instead of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services, to extend the benefits of the Oklahoma Employees Insurance and Benefits Plans to employees of municipal and county fire departments.

At this time, a fiscal impact for HB2011 is undeterminable. An actuarial analysis from the OHCA states that if there is a fiscal impact, it may take several years before it is realized, being a result of a slow migration into the Oklahoma employees benefit plans and development of certain diseases that firefighters may have a higher incidence of.
