Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

HB 2030 sets the minimum rates for foster care families.

- \$22.72 per day or \$681.60 per month for a child zero to five years of age
- \$25.42 per day or \$762.60 per month for a child who is six to 12 years of age
- \$27.62 per day or \$828.60 per month for a child 13 years or older

DHS believes this increase to cost approximately \$48,200,000 with a state share of \$25,700,000.
