## Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

HB2155 directs the Corporation Commission to promulgate rules governing the operations of energy facilities. Facility operators are required to be registered with the Commission, provide a financial security form, and obtain an approved permit from the Commission prior to commencing operations. Rules promulgated by the Commission must include a process for notifying local landowners of new facilities and collecting complaints about facility operations, and pre-existing facilities or those under construction must obtain a permit from the Commission prior to January 1, 2026.

The Corporation Commission shares that the proposal will have to allocate additional resources to process the permit requests submitted to the Public Utilities Division and require rulemaking. They estimate a fiscal impact of \$200,000 in recurring annual costs and \$50,000 in the one-time costs.
