Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

HB 2162 expands the Terry Peach Water Restoration Act to a statewide program at efforts to eradicate harmful woody species, and modifies the definition of harmful woody species to include several trees and shrubs in all watersheds in the state.

The Conservation Commission originally estimated a fiscal impact of \$10,000,000 but states that the bill could pass funded or unfunded. Passage of the proposal would authorize the work so the Commission could start when funding becomes available.
