Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

This bill modifies language regarding the transfer of students who are dependent children of active military. It removes a requirement that Oklahoma be the home of record for the active military member and that at least one parent provide evidence that he or she will be on active duty status or orders for more than 30 consecutive days. It states that student can not be precluded from enrollment prior to residency if he or she has an individualized education program or individualized family serves plan; receives or qualifies for special education courses or services; or receives or qualifies for accommodations or services under the Rehabilitation Act of 1973.

This bill has no fiscal impact.
