Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

HB2407 creates the Oklahoma Main Street Grant Program Revolving Fund and allows funds to be budgeted and expended for the purpose of preserving and developing Oklahoma main streets. The proposal requires Main Streets to apply to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce to be considered for a grant and requires the applying Main Street to be a designated and qualified Main Street by the Oklahoma Main Street Program. The measure directs that if an awardee is no longer designated a Main Street, they shall be removed from the grant program and ineligible to receive funds, and that available funds are evenly reallocated to other qualified grant awardees.

The Department of Commerce shares that there is no immediate fiscal impact.
