Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

HB2603 transfers the powers, duties, and personnel responsible for motor carrier enforcement as well as operations of fixed facilities from OCC to DPS. It creates a transitional task force to help facilitate the transfer. It requires that OCC no longer function as a law enforcement agency. It amends 47 O.S. §14-122 which requires the first \$20,000,000 to be apportioned to DPS rather than the General Revenue Fund. It provides clarifying language. It repeals Title 47 Sections 116.13 and 172.1.

The OCC anticipates a FY'26 impact of \$22,720,371 due to the \$20,000,000 transfer to DPS, loss of OCC revenue, training costs, and rulemaking costs. It anticipates a FY'27 impact of \$21,885,132 and an annually recurring impact of \$21,052,103 thereafter.
