**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1192 increases the fee for undergoing a drug assessment program related to driver's license revocation from \$160 to \$200. The measure directs the \$15 fee remitted by the individual undergoing an assessment to Service Oklahoma instead of to the Department of Safety. The measure directs 10% of the fifteen-dollar fee revenue into the Service Oklahoma Revolving Fund instead of the Department of Public Safety Revolving Fund and the remaining 90% of the fifteen-dollar fee will be deposited into Community-based Substance Abuse Revolving Fund.

The Department of Public Safety estimates a loss of \$8,827.50 in fee revenue that will now be directed to Service Oklahoma instead.
