**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB1221 would require Service Oklahoma to implement a system enabling customers to track the mailing status of driver licenses and identification cards and offer an expedited delivery option for credentials for an additional \$25 fee, to be deposited into the Service Oklahoma Revolving Fund.

The estimated annual cost to provide applicant notification and tracking services is approximately \$37,665. The proceeds from the expedited print fee net to \$6,277, resulting in a near revenue-neutral fiscal impact, with an estimated recurring net annual impact of approximately \$31,388. This amount is halved in FY'27, based upon the January 1<sup>st</sup> language in the bill.
