**Bill Summary and
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1241 prohibits the use of a bot to purchase tickets for any online admission ticket sale, the use of multiple IP addresses, purchaser accounts, or e-mail addresses to exceed posted ticket limits and the circumvention of electronic queues, presale codes, sales volume limitations, security or access control measures. Primary ticket sellers are required to disclose the total price of the ticket, itemize all taxes and fees, and the seat location on the ticket. Any violation of the provisions of the measure shall be subject to the Oklahoma Consumer Protection Act.

The Office of the Attorney General believes these responsibilities can be absorbed within the existing structure of their consumer protection unit and states there is no fiscal impact.
