**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB1243 amends multiple sections of Title 47 to require that individuals operating motor vehicles in Oklahoma be United States citizens or lawfully present in the United States. The measure requires SOK and authorized licensed operators to verify citizenship or lawful presence for issuance, renewal, or replacement of driver licenses and identification cards; restricts issuance of certain credentials; mandates additional documentation review; requires cancellation of certain licenses.

The primary operational impact of this measure would be the requirement to add new statutorily mandated language to the physical driver license and identification card. Implementing this change would require a one-time update to credential design, production specifications and related system configurations. These changes are challenging due to the limited space available on the face of the credential and the need to comply with established card standards and security requirements necessary for the credential to remain valid and usable. SOK estimates the one-time cost to modify the physical driver license design to be approximately \$100,000. This cost reflects design updates, testing and coordination with card production vendors.
