**Bill Summary and  
Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 1250 requires each school district and charter school by October 1, 2026, and each subsequent October 1 to submit to the State Department of Education a list of all books and other materials available in its school library. The measure prohibits certain explicit materials to be kept in libraries or brought on campus. It also directs the school district or charter school to receive a 5% reduction in state funding for the fiscal year following the fiscal year of noncompliance
