### Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

SB 1251 allows funds from the School Security Revolving Fund to be used by school districts to contract with a licensed mental health professional to provide counseling and social services to students. It also modifies the School Security Revolving Fund to direct that \$50 million be allocated from the fund each fiscal year for the next three fiscal years beginning July 1, 2026, to be divided equally among the school districts in the state, subject to the availability of funding.

This measure would result in a total fiscal impact of \$50 million each year for up to a total cost of \$150 million over three fiscal years. The actual fiscal impact to SDE is contingent upon future legislative funding decisions. SDE notes that additional administrative costs may be required, but that these are undeterminable at this time.
