Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

SB 1263 requires that all historic places within this state nominated to the National Register of Historic Places require the approval of the Legislature prior to designation on the State Register. The measure prohibits the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Commission from establishing or designating state trails on lands under the jurisdiction of a federal agency, and prohibits funds from being expended or transferred from the state or a political subdivision towards any such trail, without the approval of the Legislature.

The Oklahoma Historical Society and the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department share there is no fiscal impact.
